

**Patron Concerns:**

The responsibility for what a child selects, views or reads from the library collection rests solely with the child's parent or guardian. The presence of any particular materials in a library collection or on a library display does not imply endorsement of the ideas expressed in those materials.

Patrons have the right to question the inclusion of material in the collection (book, magazine, DVD, etc.) or to question displays within the library or on the website. Concerns about a particular item or display should be made known by filling out the attached form and submitting it to the Library Director, who shall retain a log or copy of forms submitted including the date of receipt, issue and actions taken by the library. The log shall be presented to the Library Commission at regular meetings.

The Library Director, with support from the Commission as needed, will decide on the appropriateness of the item or display within 30 days of the following Commission meeting and respond to the patron when a decision is made. In the meantime, the Library Director has the discretion to choose to leave the item or display, as is, or to make modifications as they see fit.
