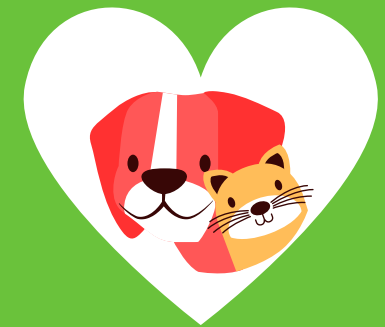

Recommended Ages 0-5

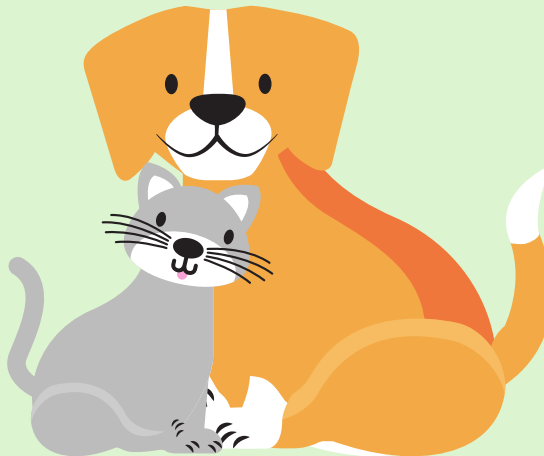
Bring your singing voice! There will be singing, dancing, bubbles and fun! This program will be held outside. No registration required.
